


REPORTABLE DISEASE!

INCIDENTAL HOST

Transmission: birds are a virus reservoir.

When these birds are bitten by a mosquito, they pass along the virus. The infected mosquito can now pass the virus along to any horse it feeds on.



VECTOR

Clinical Signs

Fever Weakness Depression Stumbling Head Pressing

Muscle Fasciculations (particularly the head and neck)

Ataxia (Incoordination) Aimless Wandering Recumbency

Treatment:

No specific treatment! SUPPORTIVE CARE ONLY

FATALITY RATE: 33%

Recovered horses may have persistent neurologic signs

Is West Nile Virus Preventable?



Vaccination against West Nile is commercially available
Recommend either annual or biannual boosters based on
geographic location
